

Guide for ordering a soap stamp.

I require a good quality picture ideally larger than the required stamp. JPG, PNG or BMP are fine but I can convert some other images. If you use a word processor to create your logo please save the document as a PDF to ensure the font is displayed correctly.

The design of the image is the key to how well the stamp will work. Fine lines and detail will not transfer to soap very well nor will fancy script fonts (see samples below). I am happy to advice before purchase if you are unsure.

The size of the image is not related to the stamp size so please provide the size in inches or metric. I normally keep the same ratio when re-sizing an image so the finished stamp may not be exactly the size given but will normally be the same as the width specified. If this is a problem please let me know when ordering.

The size you require should be the size the stamp image required on the stamp stamp. I use the start to end of the image submitted NOT including borders or NOT the size of the actual image.

Our stamps are made square or rectangle – please make it clear if you require a round stamp.

Our stamp are not made to the size of the soap but will have a thin boarder al around the image (this is to reduce the changes of the edges or corners of the stamp digging in and reduce the accuracy of how level the stamp needs to be when in use.

Some images may require enhancing or if you are unable to convert multi coloured images. If this is the case I will let you know as there may be a small charge.

The black areas of the image will end up as the raised part of the stamp and will leave an indent into the soap. I flip the image prior to creating the stamp so it comes out the correct way on the soap. Please let me know if your image is the correct way round when supplying it.

The process of stamping on soap is not the same as using a rubber stamp on paper – you are displacing the soap where the stamp is being pressed. Some of the soap will be compressed and some will be forced sideways please see the links on the order page for tips.
